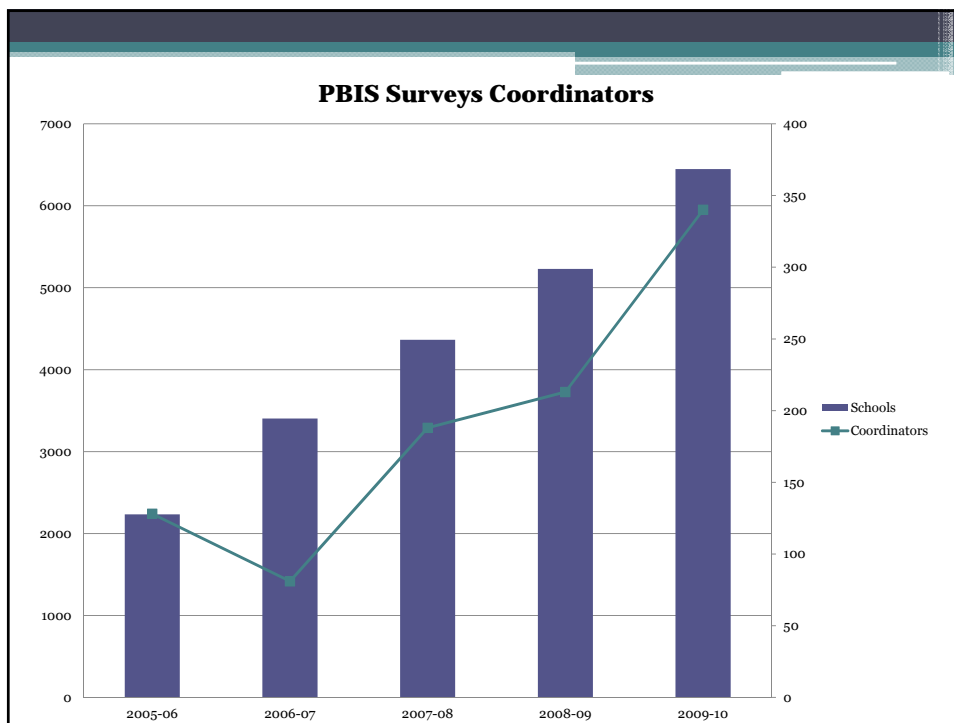

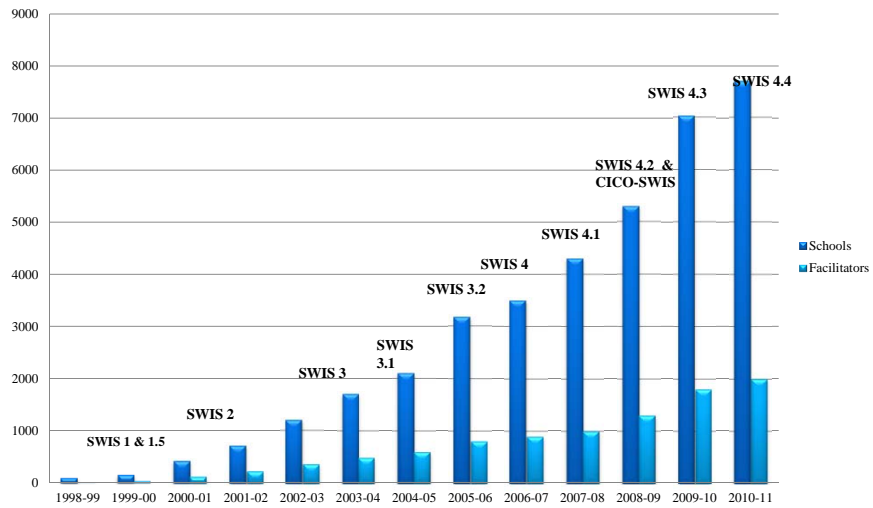

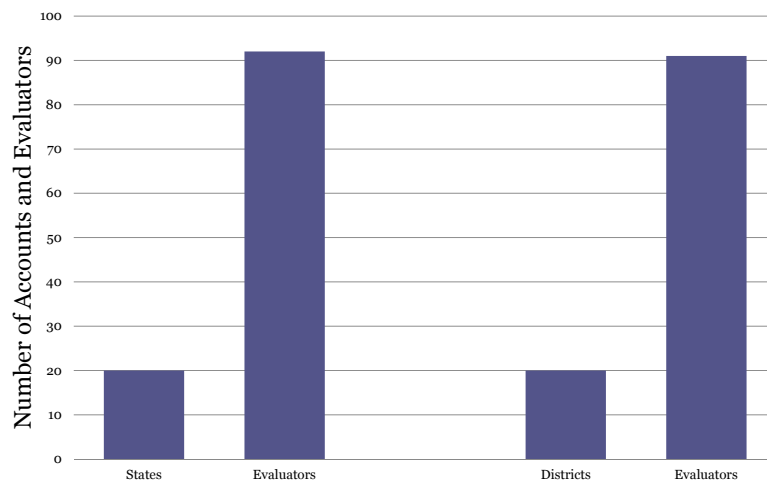

 - Select Evaluation Measures
 - Use Evaluation Information
 - Development of Action Plans



Evaluation Questions

- **Fidelity:**
 - To what extent is/was PBIS implemented as designed?
 - To what extent is/was PBIS implemented with fidelity?
- **Impact:**
 - To what extent was PBIS associated with changes in student outcomes?

Selection of Evaluation Measures

- Which measures will most accurately answer the decision questions?



Evaluation Questions

- **Fidelity:**
 - To what extent is/was PBIS implemented as designed?
 - To what extent is/was PBIS implemented with fidelity?
- **Tools within PBIS Surveys/Assessment:**
 - Team Implementation Checklist (TIC)
 - Benchmarks of Quality (BoQ)
 - Self Assessment Survey (SAS)
 - School-wide Evaluation Tool (SET)



Evaluation Questions

- **Impact:**
 - To what extent was PBIS associated with changes in student outcomes?
- **Tools available through SWIS and PBIS Surveys/Assessments:**
 - **School-wide Information System (SWIS)**
 - Office Discipline Referrals
 - Check In Check Out
 - **School Safety Survey**
 - Protection and Risk Factors



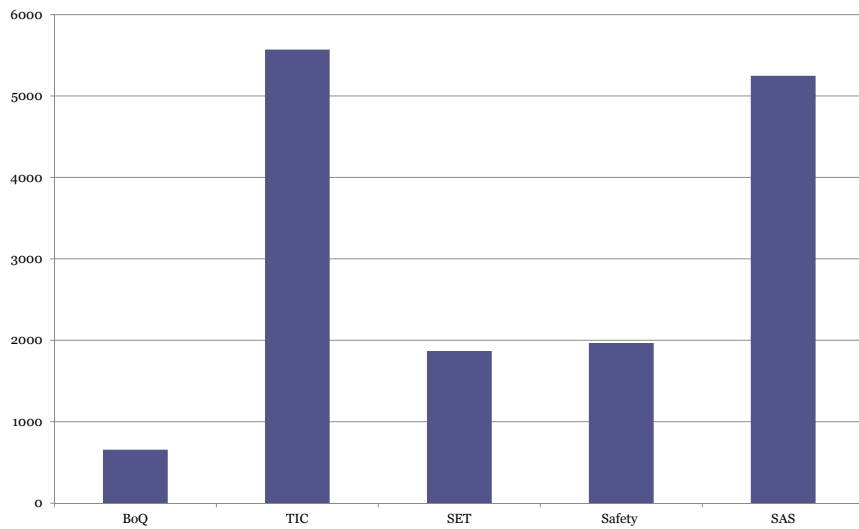
