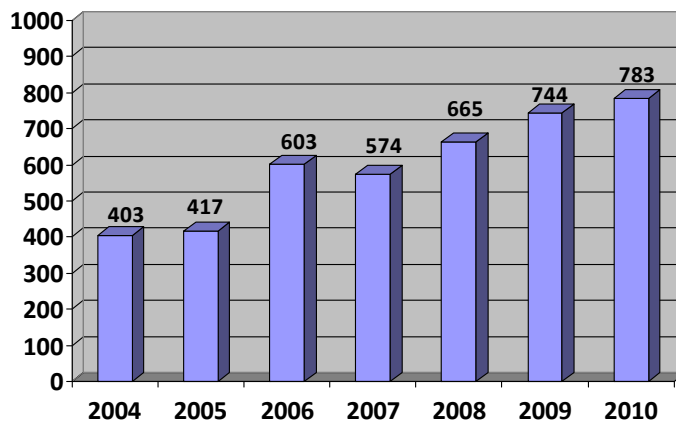

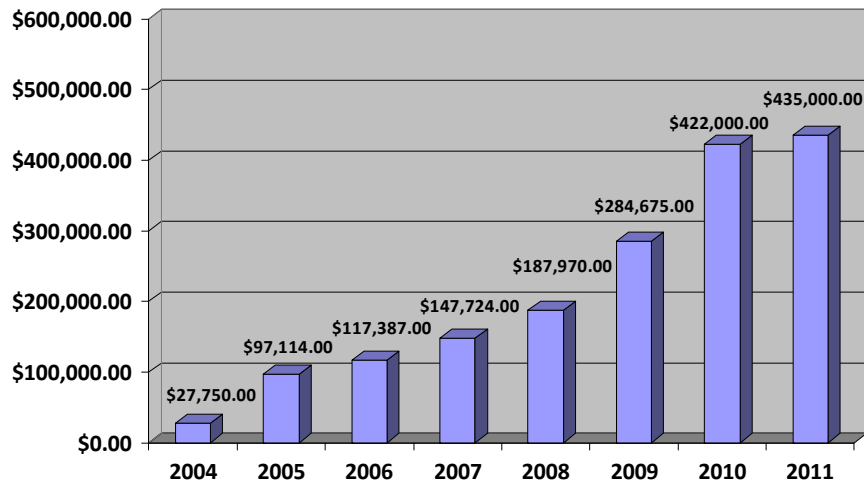

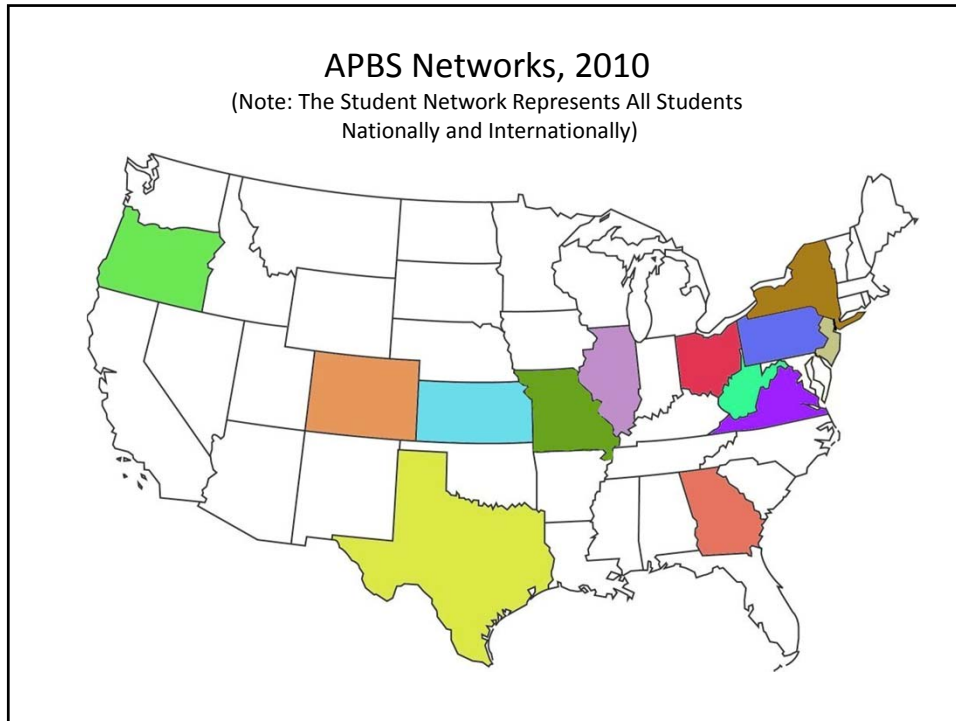

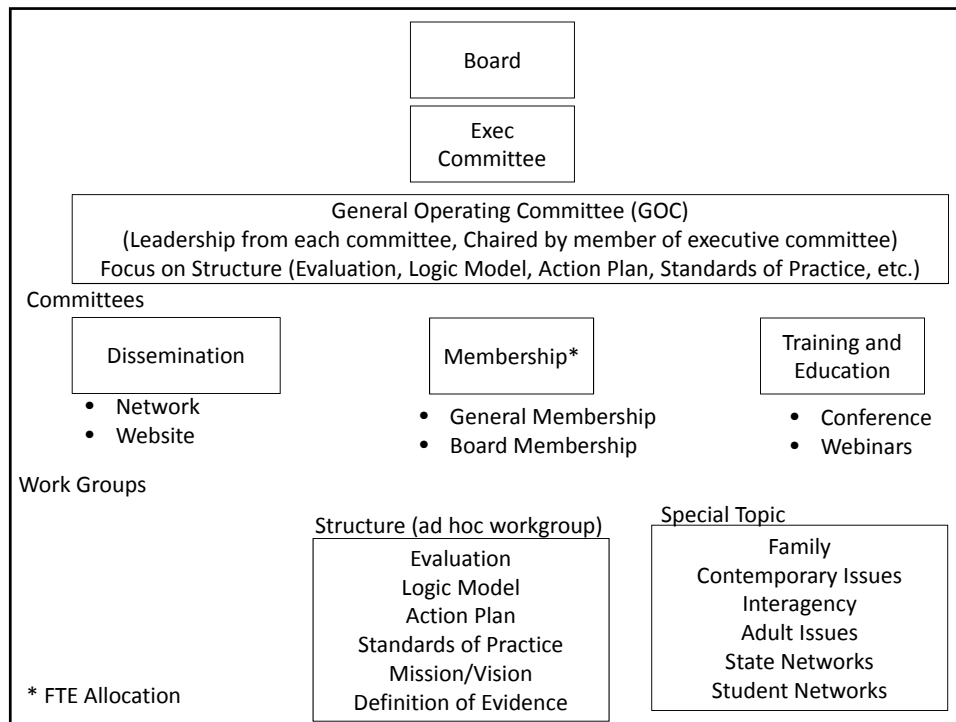

- A number of people here at the conference have not yet had time to finish reviewing the site



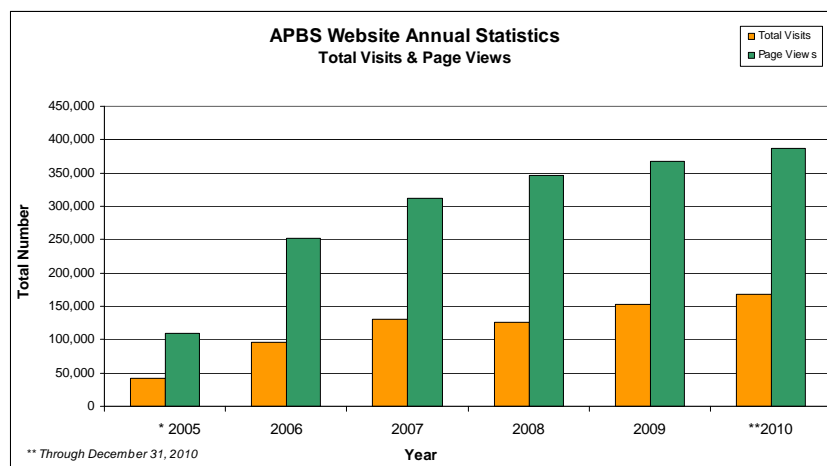

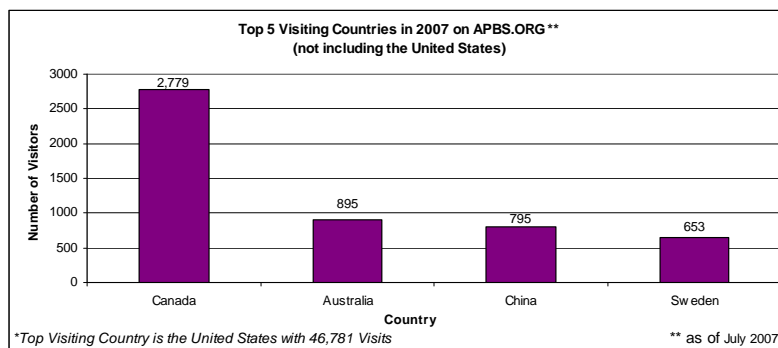


Visits and Page View Numbers

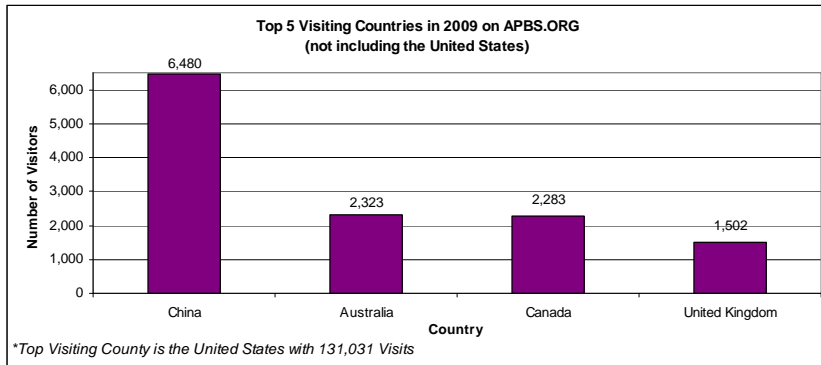
