
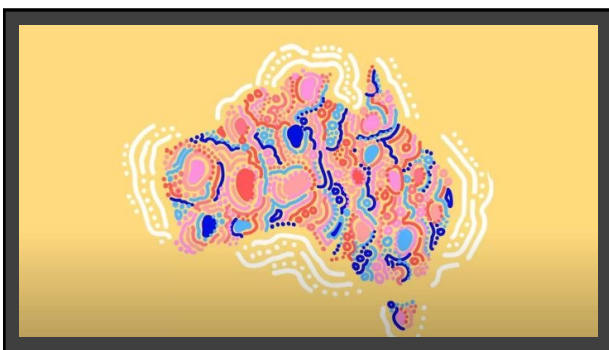

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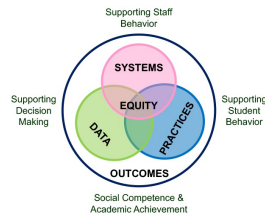

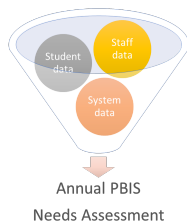
If your Education Minister was considering the future of PBS in schools, how would you convince them of the impact PBS has had so far and how could a future investment strengthen what you have achieved?
