APBS MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES (please read carefully)

Professional Membership: \$80 per year or \$200 for 3 years

Professional members are professionals in Human Services, Mental Health Services, P-12 Education, or Higher Education working to advance the practice of positive behavior support, PBIS, or Multi-level Systems of Support (MTSS) in the home, community, and/or school settings.

Family Membership: \$35 per year or \$100 for 3 years

Family members are parents, guardians, siblings, grandparents, or self-advocates not working professionally in the fields of positive behavior support, PBIS, or Multi-level Systems of Support (MTSS), and that are interested in learning about positive behavior support in home, community, and/or school settings to help themselves or their family member succeed.

Family/Professional Membership: \$80 per year or \$200 for 3 years

Family/Professional members are individuals who meet both the definition of Professional and Family Membership.

Agency Membership: \$125 per year
